MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

The February 17, 2015 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:00 P.M. Others present were Jim Wollmering, Gloria Pinke, John Maher and Marge Snyder.

Minutes of the January 20th, 2015 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the February 3rd, 2015 Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

Mr. Wasmund appeared to report on the Miller property. A letter was sent to Mr. Miller by the Township Attorney. There has been no response to this letter. Mr. Wasmund will contact the attorney tomorrow to pursue with this issue.

New Business:

Mike and Jean Schuler of 17431 Red Wing Blvd appeared to request a permit to remove an existing deck and construct a screened in porch and a four foot deck. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Brad Swanson appeared for Allen Swanson to ask about the property in Sec. 23 on 195th street. He wants to know if there is a buildable lot on this property. The board is still looking into this and will try to have an answer by the March meeting.

There has been a complaint on the property owned by Finnegan and Conciemous. This property is on the east side of Hwy 61 in Section 3. This property has a home that is unoccupied and considered to be a hazard. This was turned over to Mr. Wasmund to pursue. Also received a complaint on the property on the west side of Joan Ave. in sec. 19, that there are too many dogs and they are a nuisance with their barking. A written complaint was read on the property on Neil path, that there was a lot of Junk on this property. All these complaints were turned over to Mr. Wasmund to check in to.

Treasurer's report was given. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Bauer to renew the CUP for Little Log House Inc. which expired on December 31st, 2013 and was a 5 year CUP. This renewal would be for another 5 years, with an expiration date of February 17, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 10:40p.m.
