MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

The June 16, 2015 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:00 P.M. Others present were Jim Wollmering, Gloria Pinke, John Maher and Marge Snyder.

Minutes of the May 19, 2015 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the June 2, 2015 Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

Mr. Chuck Siebanaler appeared asking to split his property (ID# 25-01900-51-012). He would like to split off 28 acres. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve this split. Motion carried unanimously. A letter will be drafted for them to take to the county.

Dakota County Sheriff appeared asking if there were any problems in the township. There was none at this time.

Josh Mclay appeared asking for a one day gambling license for a hockey benefit which will be held at Hidden greens. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve this license. Motion carried unanimously.

Eric Thorkelson of 13185 240th St E. Hastings appeared asking to build a house on the property he purchased from Alan Swanson. This home will be 6272 sq. ft. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve the building permit for this home. Motion carried unanimously

Mr. Kee Vang of 10901 205th St. appeared asking about building 5 more greenhouses. He owns 5 acres. The board informed him he does not have enough land to build anymore greenhouses. He already has 6 greenhouses on his property.

Mr. Wasmund appeared to update the Board on the Miller property. The next step will be to contact the attorney and proceed with prosecution. He also updated the Board on the house on Hwy. 61 (16380). (The Conzemius and Finnegan property.) The Board decided to have the attorney send a letter to Conzemius to start the condemnation process.

Discussion was held to widen the bridge on 205th St. 8 feet and install a 4 foot metal culvert. Motion was made by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve the estimate from Kimmes Enterprises for \$30,000. Motion carried unanimously. Repair on the bridge will start right away.

Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to move 75,000.00 to checking from Money market. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 11.00p.m.
