MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

The May 17th, 2016 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:00 P.M. Others present were Jim Wollmering, Gloria Pinke, Marge Snyder and John Maher.

Minutes of the April 19th, 2016 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

The minutes of the May 3rd, 2016 Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

Ron Wasmund of Inspectron Inc. appeared to report on the Miller property. His application was incomplete so at this time there will not be a public hearing. He also reported on the business being conducted on the Tom Maher property, he will continue to work with Mr. Maher on this.

New Business

Dennis Deutsch and his son Brian appeared to split 2.82 acre parcel on his property. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve this split. Motion carried unanimously.

Mike and Kate Biermaier appeared to inquire about the property that they built a fence on. This fence is on Mr. Alan Swanson's property. They were told that Mr. Swanson would lose his building site if he were to sell them some of the property. They were told they would have to move there fence.

Dan Raskob of 20651 Michael Ave appeared for a permit to build a 30x40 foot storage building. He is going to remove an existing 20x60 foot building. He is able to meet all setbacks. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve this permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Sheri King appeared asking for a permit to build a home at 17150 Red Wing Blvd. The lot is 4.8 acres. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Josh and Melissa Evans appeared to ask questions about purchasing a piece of property from Alan Swanson. This property is in the shore land Buffer and needs to go to the county.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve this lot is buildable pending county approval; this lot is the SE quarter of NE quarter of sec15. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Bauer appeared about his 3 buildings that had just burned. He would like to move Cushman building from one area of his property to the area where the building had burned. He would also like to move in a Weaving/loom building. The size of this building is 20x20. Motion by Pinke to approve and seconded by Wollmering. Motion carried unanimously.

Matt Francis appeared asking about a split on his property. He is going to get the property surveyed and then come back to a meeting.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to raise the Clerks fee to \$800.00 per month plus meetings and raise the treasures fee to \$300.00 per month plus meetings. This would be retroactive to Jan 1, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the Application for Assemblage of large numbers of people for the Little Log House Property. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's report was given. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to move all money from money market #189707 to the checking. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Bauer and seconded by Pinke to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 11:15p.m.
