## MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

The August 16, 2016 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:00 P.M. Others present were Gloria Pinke, Jim Wollmering, Marge Snyder and John Maher.

Minutes of the July 19th, 2016 Town Board meeting was read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the August 2nd, 2016 Planning Commission meeting was read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2016 Special Board Meeting was read. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

### **Old Business:**

Ron Wasmund of Inspectron Inc. appeared, discussion was held on Mr. Miller. Mr. Wasmund is going to contact the attorney regarding Mr. Miller.

### **New Business**

Jerry Peine, of 1340 W. 14<sup>th</sup> St, Hastings appeared to inquire if he would be able to build a shed with living quarters inside of the shed. The size would be 42x75 with 1000 sq. ft. of living space (20x30 with a loft.) The rest of the shed would be an open shed. He was told he would not be able to build a house on this property later because of the 1 home per 40 acre ordinance. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to table this issue until next month. Motion carried unanimously.

Dakota Co Sherriff appeared to update the Board members and public on what is happening in the township.

Randy Gilb appeared to build a garage on his property. This would be only 8' from the side set back. He was told he will have to have a public hearing.

Mr. Tom and Gary Fox and Jake Marthaler appeared to do a land split on the property they are selling to Mr. Marthaler. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the split.

Steve Bauer appeared to build a new building 60x160 steel building for the antique tractors on Little Log House property. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve this building permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Tetzluff appeared to get an update on the property next to him. He had appeared at last month meeting with a complaint. Mr. Wasmund has been working on this and has sent a letter to Mr. Mellon.

Paul Hofstad appeared to update the process of when he will be able to start the process of applying for an IUP for his business. Attached is a letter he gave to the board. He plans to have a plan by October or November.

Treasurer's report was given. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously

Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 11.00a.m.
