MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING April 15, 2014

The April, 2014 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:00 P.M. Others present were Jim Wollmering, Joe Birk, Marge Snyder and John Maher.

Minutes of the March 18th Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Birk to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the planning commission meeting of April 1st, 2014 were read. Motion by Birk and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

New Business:

Richard Bauer of 20477 Kirby Ave appeared to request a permit to construct a machine shed on his farm located on the east side of Kirby and 205th. The shed will be 60'x152' with 18' sidewalls. Mr. Bauer will remove two old buildings and construct the new machinery shed on the same location. They are able to meet all setbacks. This shed will be used for storage of farm machinery. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Birk to approve this permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Kee Vang of 10901 205th St. E. appeared to request permission to install gravel bed on his 5 acre residential parcel (PID 25-02900-26-014). This gravel area would be used for storage of semi-truck trailers. He would like to start a trucking business. This trucking business is not related to agriculture. Mr. Vang also currently has 3 additional trucks that are used for his vegetable growing business, which is located on this 5 acre parcel. The board informed Mr. Vang that he could have only his own truck and trailer on his property. He was also told he would not be granted an Interim Use Permit (IUP) to start a trucking business at his home because it is unrelated to agricultural use. Mr. Vang was also told by the Board that he needs to clean up this property.

Eric Torkelson appeared asking about another piece of property, whether it is a buildable lot or not. The property is owned by Moliter Limited Partnership. It is ½ mile off 190th St. in the N.E. corner of section 22. He was told this was a buildable lot. He is going to get the property surveyed and then call the Clerk for a split letter to go to the county.

Dakota County Sherriff appeared asking if there were any concerns. There were none.

Motion by Birk and seconded by Wollmering to approve the final draft CUP with changes from the Planning Commission minutes for River Country CO-OP. A new CUP will be drafted and then signed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Birk to approve the application and permit for a 1-4 day temporary on –sale Liquor License for the All Saints Music Festival to be held on 5-16-2014. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer’s report was given. Motion by Birk and seconded by Wollmering to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Birk to adjourn meeting. Meeting adjourned at 10:30 P.M.
