MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

The May 19th, 2015 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:04 P.M. Others present were Jim Wollmering, Gloria Pinke, John Maher and Marge Snyder.

Minutes of the April 21st, 2015 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the May 5, 2015 Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the split for Alan and Brenda Swanson for a 13.32 Acre parcel. The parcel # is 25-02300-50-011. A letter was drafted and given to the Swanson's to take to the County. Motion carried unanimously.

Matt Heikes appeared asking for a building permit for a pole shed. This building is for personal use only. This building size is 100x24 and 40x40. This is a T shaped building the side walls are 16.6'. Mr. Joe Lusian appeared to object to him putting in a culvert and he was concerned about water going into his basement. The board and the building inspector did not foresee there was any problem with the water way. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve this permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Dakota County sheriff appeared asking if the township has any concerns. He was told about 4-wheelers tearing up the roads.

Aric Connell of 444 Robert Drive Hastings appeared asking for information on a piece of property he owns on Neil Path. He owns 16 acres. He is interested in selling this property and was asking if he could divide this property into two parcels. The board said he was not able to divide this parcel.

Larry Schlomka, 17560 Northfield Blvd appeared asking for his building permit for a shed, which he applied for in March, 2015. This permit was approved in March pending a letter from the adjoining property owner and a site map, which he was able to produce both of these. No other action was needed.

Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 11.00p.m.
