## MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

The September 15, 2015 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:00 P.M. Others present were Jim Wollmering, Gloria Pinke, John Maher and Marge Snyder.

Minutes of the August 18th, 2015 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the September 1st, 2015 Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

### Old Business:

There was none

### New Business:

Dakota County Sherriff appeared. He reported there has been a car in the area just driving up and down driveway and there have been some robberies in the area.

Jill Tresscott of Dakota County appeared to give a presentation on drinking water quality in private wells in Dakota County, also the nitrate contamination. There was a question asked, if there is a well in Dakota County that is not being used, does the county require it to be closed and does the county follow up on this. Her answer was yes.

Brent Huneke of 13585 193<sup>rd</sup> Way E. appeared asking to build a shed (stick building) on his property. The size is 50'x80'. The use of the building is for personal storage. He plans to remove 3 small temporary existing buildings that are on the property. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve the building permit with the condition that he removes the three existing out buildings within 6 months of completion of the new building. Motion carried unanimously.

Tom Green of SoCore Energy who is working with Dakota Electric was inquiring about the process of putting in a solar facility. He was asking for a 5 to 10 acre project. The Board would like to have Mr. Dean Johnson come to a meeting to discuss this process.

Steve Bauer 21889 Michael appeared asking for a permit for a Hay shed 34x64 open sided to the south. The building will be approx. 500 feet north of 210<sup>th</sup> on Michael. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve this permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Pat Sajevic gave a report on Building Permits in our township. Discussion was held on a process we will begin by talking to the attorney and Mr. Dean Johnson on what our next steps are.

Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to accept the quote from Kimmes Ent. Motion carried unanimously. Quote is attached.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 11:15p.m.
