MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

The March 15th, 2016 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:00 P.M. Others present were Jim Wollmering, Gloria Pinke, Marge Snyder and John Maher.

Minutes of the February, 2016 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

The minutes of the March 1, 2016 Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the Annual meeting held on March 8th, 2016 were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

Ron Wasmund of Inspectron Inc. appeared to report on the Conzemius/Finnegan property. Mr. Wasmund said the home is going to be torn down very soon.

Mr. Miller appeared about the letter he received from our attorney. He is going to fill out the application for an IUP for an Excavating business and get it to the clerk within two weeks. He also plans to sell some of the equipment very soon. He will be working with Ron Wasmund on this.

New Business

Dakota County sheriff appeared and didn't have anything to report at this time. Spoke a little about the garbage being dumped on our township roads.

Jim Goersch appeared asking questions on the process of remodeling a home. He was told he would have to come to the planning commission meeting with some plans.

John Welch appeared asking questions about a men's group home, he would like to start this on the property of skips towing. He wanted 20 patients. He was told our ordinance only allows 6. No action was taken.

Ron Orres of 12770 200th Street E. appeared to build a shed. This shed would be 30'x40' and used for personal storage. He is able to meet all setbacks. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Weiderholt appeared asking for a permit to have an all saint's music festival on May 20th, 2016 this also includes a temporary Liquor License. Motion by Wollmering and seconded

by Pinke to approve the permit and liquor license. A letter was given to Mrs. Weiderholt to take to the county. Motion carried unanimously.

Paul Hofstad of 10770 180th Street appeared because he received a letter from Mr. Wasmund about the business he is conducting at Tom Maher's home. He is conducting a landscaping business. He is going to fill out an application for a public hearing. He plans to attend the next meeting and will keep Mr. Wasmund informed.

Treasurer's report was given. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Bauer to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 10:50p.m.
