MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

Minutes of the Public Hearing held on March 5th, 2016 were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Allan Swanson and Mike and Kate Biermaier appeared to inquire about purchasing a small portion of land from Mr. Swanson. This is to solve the problem of the fence which was built by the Biermaier is on the property of Mr. Swanson. The Board will check into this.

Matt Heikes appeared about his plans for a building. He is working on his plans and had some questions.

Jim Goerish appeared to add a 24x26 garage and a 12x19 ft. breezeway to his existing home. He has approx. 5 acres. He is able to meet all setbacks. Motion by Wollmering and seconded by Pinke to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Matt Francis appeared asking if he had a buildable lot on his property and he was informed that there was no buildable lot on his property.

Treasurer's report was given. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Wollmering to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.
