MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

June 18, 2019

The June meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Jerry Bauer. Others present were Beau Steuart, Gloria Pinke, Marge Snyder and John Maher.

Minutes of the May 21, 2019 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the June 4th, 2019 Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the June 4th 2019 Public Hearing was read. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business: There was none

New Business:

Ron and Scott Kersner of 12029 180th St. appeared asking for a permit to build a building 2400 sq. feet for personal use. He is able to meet all setbacks. He has 5.09 acers. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to approve this building permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Doug Corrington of 14949 210th St. E. appeared for permit to build a barn to replace the one which had burned this last summer. The board told him he does not need a permit.

James McNamara 11223 180th St. asking if he can build a building on Herb Kapsner land. He was told by the board he can build it on that property and he does not need a permit as it is Ag related.

Tom Maher and Robert Fritz of W6656 340th Ave Ellsworth Wis. appeared asking for a CUP. The business is on 1.82 acres. Mr. Maher wants to sell his well drilling business to Mr. Fritz. They were told by the board they need to get a CUP. This business has been at this location since in the 60s.

Bart Shanks appeared asking about the property owned by Erik Connell. He just wanted information about building a home and out buildings. He plans to buy 15.01 acres.

Discussion was held on the sign for the golf course. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to send another letter to Hidden greens as the sign on Hwy 61, which is the older sign that has been for some time. This sign does not meet the Township ordinance.

Discussion was held on the Mellon case. Attached is a copy of the letter from the attorney that was sent to Mr. Mellon. Mr. Wasmund will do an inspection on July 1st and proceed after the

inspection.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to move \$17,000.00 from the fire fund to pay a partial payment on the fire bill and \$5,000.00 from the money market. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to adjourn meeting. Meeting closed at 10:50p.m.
