MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING August 21, 2018

The August, 2018 meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer at 8:00 P.M. Others present were Gloria Pinke, Beau Steuart, Marge Snyder and John Maher.

Minutes of the July, 2018 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the August Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business

The Dakota County Sherriff appeared to ask if there were any concerns of the township members. He reported on the progress of the road construction.

Al Gale appeared to ask questions about the ordinance and why the ordinance is written the way it is.

Mr. Aric Connell appeared asking about his property of 16 acres. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to approve that this property has a building lot and the Board has apologized for the misunderstanding of last month, which it was voted on that it was not a building lot. The clerk was advised to send a letter to Mr. Connell stating he has a buildable lot on his property.

Mr. Miller appeared asking about the variance that he would like to get so he is able to build the buildings he would like. The Board would like more time to study this before any action is taken. Mr. Miller submitted an application for a variance including the fee to build the buildings to store all his equipment in.

Mr. Paul Krueger of 12350 190th Street East appeared asking for a permit to build a building 30x36. He is able to meet all setbacks. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Gene Kieffer of 19380 Lillehei Ave. requested a building permit for a 30x40 detached garage. He is able to meet all setbacks. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Todd Brewster of 13550 210th St. appeared asking about trading 50ft. of Angie Bauer's property because some of his buildings were on Angie Bauer's property.

Mr. Slavic appeared to report on the roads in Marshan Township. He also gave an update on the Vermillion River Watershed.

The two quotes which were received for road maintenance were discussed. Copy of quotes is attached. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to award the road maintenance to Jerry Kimmes of Kimmes Enterprises. Motion carried unanimously. It was also discussed that the board would like a more detailed billing, including the hours worked on the roads.

Discussion held on the chloride. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to do a light application on all gravel roads in township. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 11:15.m.
