MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING September 17, 2019

The September meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Jerry Bauer. Others present were Beau Steuart, Gloria Pinke, Marge Snyder and John Maher.

Minutes of the August 2019 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the September 3rd planning commission meeting and the public hearing were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve the minutes as read and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

Mr. Wasmund appeared and gave a report on the Denn property. Mr. Wasmund also reported on the Melon case

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve assessing the Melon property for cost related to clean up of the property PID # 25-00800-54-011. The cost is unknown at this time, but it must be finished and to the County by October 15th. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

Jerry and Kris Donndelinger and Frances Donndelinger appeared asking about their property. The neighbors have a built a shed partly on their property. The neighbors would like to buy the .4 acres, but the Donndelinger are not sure they want to sell it. Motion by Steuart to search for the building permit for the building which the neighbors have built on the Donndelinger property. Motion seconded by Pinke. Motion carried unanimously.

Joe and Jennie Slattery appeared about their building permit they had inquired about last month. They explained how they understood the ordinance and where their building will be located. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve the permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Brad Saueressig appeared checking on a permit for a pole machine shed. He was informed he does not need a permit for a farm building. He has enough land to qualify for a farm building.

Mr. Ken Friz appeared as he was asked to by the Board. The issue of the complaint of burning brush from the neighbor which was brought to the attention of the Board last month was discussed. The board has agreed upon and told him he is not allowed to burn any of his brush from his job sites. He is only able to burn for recreational use. He said he would not burn any of his brush on his property anymore.

Tom Maher appeared asking about his application for a CUP he has applied for. This CUP is for a well drilling business. The land scape business that is on the property now, will be gone if this permit is issued. Motion by Pinke to issue Mr. Maher a CUP and seconded by Steuart. Motion carried unanimously. Conditions will be set. Mr. Maher will appear on Oct. 15th to sign and have the permit notarized.

Discussion was held on the 2020 Levy. At the annual meeting in March the Levy was set as follows:

General Levy - \$150,000.00

Road & Bridge - \$175,000.00

Fire - \$110,000.00

After the discussion of the wet spring the board felt they should change the levy.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to raise the general levy to \$200,000.00 and leave the others as they were set in the spring. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Bauer to approve the contract for Road Maintenance to Jerry Kimmes. Motion seconded by Pinke. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to approve the Resolution adopting the 2040 Dakota County Rural Collaborative Comprehensive Plan Update. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurers Report was given. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Bauer to approve the Treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Bauer and seconded by Pinke to adjourn meeting. Meeting closed at 11.00p.m.
