## MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING & Public Hearing November 20, 2018

The Public Hearing was opened at 7pm. This hearing was for a Variance for Mr. Miller. The Notice was read. Mr. Alex Consemius explained the process for a Variance application for Mr. Miller. Comments from the public were taken. The public hearing was then closed at 7:15p.m.

The regular November meeting of the Marshan Town Board was then opened and called to order by Jerry Bauer immediately after the public hearing. Others present were Beau Steuart, Gloria Pinke, Marge Snyder and John Maher.

A Motion was made by Pinke to approve the variance for Mr. Mike Miller. Motion seconded by Steuart. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the October, 2018 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the November Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

### **Old Business:**

Mr. Wasmund reported on the Mellon property. The vehicles were to be moved off the property today as per the court order. Mr. Wasmund was there along with the Dakota Co. Sherriff. A report is attached.

### **New Business:**

Mr. McNamara appeared to ask about a land split on the property belonging to the McNamara Trust. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to approve the land split for the McNamara Trust. Motion carried unanimously.

Some of the citizens who were in attendance had a complaint about the garbage being dumped along the side of the roads. They were told that the Township is aware of the dumping and will try to have all this picked up.

There were some citizens who appeared with complaints about the Denn property. It needs to be cleaned up. Mr. Wasmund was informed of this property. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to give permission to Mr. Wasmund to start the process of cleaning up the property. Motion carried unanimously.

Dakota Co. Sherriff appeared to ask if there were any concerns of the Board or the public. He also was informed of the property in question to be cleaned up.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Stewart to approve the treasurers report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 11:15.m.
