MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

April 21, 2020

The April meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Chairman Jerry Bauer. Others present were Gloria Pinke, Beau Steuart, Clerk, Marge Snyder and Treasurer, John Maher

Minutes of the February and March 2020 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the Planning Commission were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business: None

New Business

Looked over the application from Eric Nordling. This permit is for a pool house. He is able to meet all set-backs. Motion by Stewart and seconded by Pinke to approve the permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Midwest Asphalt appeared about selling the gravel pit to New Look Contracting. Discussion was held on whether or not they will have the same type of business that Midwest has. They said it was all the same.

The town board would like something in permit stating they will address the issue of run off Also, that they would take care of additional dust control.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Stewart to get a \$50,000 bond and a \$10,000 escrow from the new buyers. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke to allow the amended permit with the additions. Motion seconded by Stewart. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart to pull the permit for the campground and renegotiate a permit that fits his current status. Motion failed for a 2nd.

Looked over the application for a greenhouse from Ambrey Gartner of 19435 Kerby Ave. He is able to meet all set-backs. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to approve the permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Due to the Hasting Gazette going out of business, the Township has to approve a new paper to put public notices in. Motion by Pinke seconded by Steuart to have Dakota County Tribune for our official newspaper. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was held on a new web site. The clerk has checked on a few sites and asked to go with Go Daddy to set up a new site for the township. The total cost is 1939.87. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to go ahead with this. Motion carried unanimously.

Jerry Bauer submitted a Resignation Letter to the Board affective as of April 21st. 2020. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to accept his resignation. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to adjourn meeting. Meeting was adjourned at 10:45p.m.
