MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

May 19, 2020

The May meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Gloria Pinke. Others present were, Beau Steuart, Clerk, Marge Snyder and Treasurer, John Maher

Minutes of the April 2020 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the Planning Commission were read. Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business: None

New Business

Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to appoint Andy Tetzlaff as a new Board member to replace Jerry Bauer, who has resigned. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart and Seconded by Tetzlaff to appoint Pinke as chairman of the Board. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Chad Brown of 9522 160th St. E. appeared to request a permit to build a 42'x72' building. He will have 14' sidewalls. He owns 5.03 acres. Mr. Brown is able to meet all set-backs. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Tetzlaff. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Pinke and seconded by Steuart to appoint Chad Brown to the planning commission. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Chris Quiring appeared with his builder, Doug Speedling inquiring about building a new home on Michael Ave. PID# 25-02600-26-014 He has 5.01 acres. Motion by Tetzlaff and seconded by Steuart to approve the permit. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart and seconded by Tetzlaff to hold our meetings at 7 pm. Instead of 8p.m. going forward. Motion carried unanimously.

The representatives from New Look Contracting came to ask about there permit. It was suggested they have the trucks only enter or leave from the north entrance of the gravel pit. It was discussed about the run off and how to solve the issue. It was decided to get the permit done as soon as possible with all changes and continue this meeting until Tuesday the 26th of May at 7pm. At this time the permit can be signed and notarized.

Xavier Kopp of 210th appeared to ask where he can build a shed and his house, because of his unique land situation. He is going to get the house and garage plans done first and come back to another meeting in the future.

Nick Jablonski appeared requesting information for the right of way permits for laying fiber optics cables. We need to check with Township Officers Association to find out if we can do this on township roads. The township will contact him when they get answers.

John Maher has agreed to be the representative for the township on the Rural Fire association board.

Motion by Steuart to send the CUP for review to our attorney to conclude if the Refuge is a seasonal living or if he is a recreational campground. Motion was seconded by Tetzlaff. Motion carried unanimously.

The clerk is asked to send a letter to Kenneth and Lila Sheldahl at 1006 15th St W Hastings MN 55033. The Property in concern is 20185 Lillehei Ave. This home has been empty for some time and is overcome with weeds and has several vehicles on the property.

Motion by Tetzlaff to pay the road supervisor who is Beau Steuart \$100.00 per month extra pay. Motion seconded by Pinke. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart and seconded by Pinke to have all three board members and the Clerk and Treasurer as signers on checks. Names below:
