The July meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Gloria Pinke. Others present were, Beau Steuart, Andy Tetzlaff, Clerk, Marge Snyder and Treasurer, John Maher

Minutes of the June 2020 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Tetzlaff and seconded by Pinke to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the July 2020 of the Planning Commission meeting were read. Motion by Tetzlaff and seconded by Steuart to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

### Old Business:

### New Business:

Suzanne Schmidt of 12414 191<sup>st</sup> St. E. appeared to ask questions about the business she has just purchased from Sam Kadem. This business does not need a permit because it will be agriculture. She was also checking on putting up a sign.

Motion by Steuart to approve this land split with the information we have at this time. Motion seconded by Tetzlaff. Motion carried unanimously.

Kenneth Sheldahl appeared because he was asked to by the board. He owns the red empty home on Hwy. 61. He plans to get it cleaned up by Sept 15. Clerk will send a letter to him that he can sign and send it back to the clerk stating he will have it cleaned up by Sept. 15<sup>th</sup> 2020.

Xavier Kopp appeared to ask if he can get a permit now and build later. He was told yes.

Jim Johnson from Barga Inc. appeared to discuss the blacktop which needs repairing. He gave a quote as follows:

Orlando Ave for 1000.00

195<sup>th</sup> St. for 16,800.00

170<sup>th</sup> for 14,000.00

For a total of \$46,600.00

Beau Steuart gave a report on the roads.

Discussion was held on the campgrounds, the clerk was asked to send letter to Lee Stokke about amending or changing his permit.
