MARSHAN TOWNSHIP MEETING

August 18, 2020

The August meeting of the Marshan Town Board was called to order by Gloria Pinke. Others present were, Beau Steuart, Andy Tetzlaff, Clerk, Marge Snyder and Treasurer, John Maher

Minutes of the July 2020 Town Board meeting were read. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Tetzlaff to approve and place on file. Motion carried unanimously.

There were no minutes of the Planning Commission meeting for August. This meeting was canceled.

Old Business:

Ron Wasmund appeared and reported on the Miller case. Nothing more has happened since last month.

Discussed the Temple and their new construction at this time. Ron is going to send us a copy of the permit

Mr. Wasmund reported on the Denn property. He is sending her a letter. He is also sending a letter to the homeowner of the red house on Hwy 61 that is empty.

New Business:

It was discussed that the planning commission should not cancel their meetings without letting the Board know. The August meeting which was canceled had some public who attended this meeting.

Discussed the public hearing for New Look Contracting and wondering if the meeting has been put in paper.

Bellwood oaks golf course liquor license. Motion by Steuart and seconded by Tetzlaff to go ahead and sign the liquor license. Carried unanimously

Road up-date by Steuart. Barga has been working on the blacktop roads. Steuart is going to talk to Kimmes about chloride for the fall application.

Report on the leaking stool in Bathroom. This has been fixed.

Mr. Miller appeared to explain when he was going to build his buildings to put his equipment inside. He plans to start putting up the buildings by October. The board asked him if he does not start building by Oct. 15 if he would appear at the meeting in Oct.

Mr. Peter Aguirre Sr. of 19605 Joan Ave. appeared to get a permit to build a shed. He has 10.6 acres of land. He was given a permit to fill out and was told he could build up to 3200 sq. feet. He will come back to the next month's meeting.

Motion by Steuart to approve the land split for Eric Connell PID # 25-01100-06-010 He has a 16 acre parcel with 3 acres split off. There is no buildable lot on this parcel. Also his remaining 13 acres still have a buildable lot. Motion carried unanimously.

Jacob Razac from Dakota County appeared asking about a field entrance for the repairing of Nicolai Ave. This would be on 210th St. and no field entrance on Nicolai Ave. PID# 25-02600-75-010 Motion by Tetzlaff and seconded by Steuart to approve. Motion carried unanimously.

Steuart reported on the new furnace and the quotes.

Motion by Tetzlaff and seconded by Steuart to have the clerk fill out the application for the cares act money. Motion carried unanimously.

Levy- Motion by Tetzlaff to leave our levy at the same as it was set in the spring. Motion seconded by Steuart. Motion carried unanimously. The Levy is as follows:

Fire-\$110,000.00

Road & Bridge-\$175,000.00

General-\$200,000.000

The Treasurer's Report was given. Motion by Tetzlaff and seconded by Steuart to approve the Treasurer's report as read and printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart and seconded by Tetzlaff to move 3372.38 from checking to fire fund. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Steuart and seconded by Tetzlaff to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 9:50p.m.
